School rules for responsible internet use:

- I will ask permission before using the internet.

- All messages I send will be polite and sensible following SMART rules.
- I understand I must never give my home address, phone number or any personal details to anyone on the internet and I must never arrange to meet anyone over the internet.
- I will ask permission before opening an email or an email attachment sent by someone I do not know.
- If I see anything I am not happy with or receive messages I do not like, I will tell my teacher immediately.
- I understand that the school may check my computer files and the internet sites I visit.
- I understand that if I break these rules, I may be banned from the internet and use of iPads and Computers.
- I understand children under the age of 13 should not be using social media platforms.
- I will only play age appropriate games and apps at home and I will not use internet chatrooms or apps that are not appropriate.

2 Simple – Evidence Me Agreement:

As you are probably aware, the Early Years Foundation Stage has its own curriculum.

Part of our ethos at **2 Simple – Evidence Me**, is to give you as families the very best of outstanding practice with cutting edge ideas and developments, that makes your children's learning and development very apparent and relevant to you as parents.

2 Simple – Evidence Me is an Electronic Learning Journey which uses a secure hand held tablet to collect not only photographs, but also video and audio clips as well. These are then linked to the appropriate areas of the EYFS. Each classroom has their own tablet and the information is stored on a secure server which is encrypted and password protected. It can only be accessed by your child's class teacher or other staff in the EYFS.
